1. Mousetraps are 2.00 each for up to 10 mousetraps, then any additional moustraps after the first 10 are just 1.50 each. (*For example:* for 13 mousetraps, the cost is 24.50.) Write a function `mousetrap_cost` that returns the cost for a given number of mousetraps.

2. (You can do this part whether or not you did the first part correctly.) Assume that your function `mousetrap_cost` is in a module called `stuff.py`. Write another Python script which *uses* the `mousetrap_cost` function to create a short interactive program. Your program should prompt the user to enter a number of mousetraps and then print the cost. (Don't rewrite the `mousetrap_cost` function, just import the `stuff` module!)
